From 1997 to 1999 ( 2 Years), the following significant events occurred at Planned Parenthood & Public Health sexual health clinics

- 1) Combined Annual Funding declined 11.4%
- 2) Combined weekly operating hours declined 29.7%
- 3) Attendance by clients under 19 years of age declined 57%
- 4) Pregnancy rates for Hamilton's 15-19 yr olds declined 22.4%

This lower 1999 pregnancy rate translates into approximately 194 fewer pregnant 15-19 yr olds for the year 1999.
